



Kineton Christmas Tree Trail

The Trail

The trail will consist of 300-500 individually decorated and themed Christmas trees sponsored by local businesses, charities and individuals, creating a mapped walking trail all around the village of Kineton and Little Kineton, making the village the place in Warwickshire to visit this December. Maps will be available to purchase (£2.50) from village shops and the proceeds will be donated to local charities.

The trail will be launched on Friday 29th November during the Victorian Christmas Evening and will remain in place throughout the whole of December for you to enjoy with family and friends.

The theme this year for the tree decorating is 'The Wonderful World of Books' – so get creative, it doesn't just have to be fiction books, some examples include The Haynes Car Manual, Harry Potter, Mary Berry's Cookbook, War and Peace, Lord of The Rings.....

The Tree's

A 5 – 5.5ft Norwegian Spruce tree without stand is available at a cost of £16. Alternatively, a 5 -5.5ft tree stabilized on a wooden block is available at a cost of £20.

All trees will be available to collect on Saturday 23rd November, giving you a week to create your display.

After the event, trees (minus their decorations) will be shredded and the chippings used to improve village footpaths.
